HOWICK INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL PROCEDURES ON INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FEE REFUNDS

GUIDELINES:

- 1. Requests for refunds will be considered on a case by case basis. Requests must be submitted in writing at least two weeks in advance.
- 2. If an enrolment application is withdrawn after the student has been accepted or a student leaves the school before completing their full term of enrolment, an administration fee will be retained by the school.
- 3. The Government levy for international students is non-refundable.
- 4. Once a student has commenced their study at Howick Intermediate, no refunds will be given for enrolments of one term or less.
- 5. In the case of enrolments for more than one term, refunds will be considered on a case by case basis and where an application for refund has been made in writing prior to the end of a school term.
- 6. An administration fee of \$500 will be deducted from any refund. In the case of a two year enrolment, an administration fee of \$800 will be deducted.
- 7. Where a student ceases to be an international student during the year, their continued enrolment in the school will be reliant on them living within the school zone.
- 8. No refunds will be made to students who are asked to leave Howick Intermediate School because of misbehaviour or poor attendance.
- 9. The camp fee is not refundable where a student leaves the school within one month of the camp date.
- 10. For short stay enrolments of up to one term:
 - If a visa is declined by Immigration New Zealand, or in the situation of a Force Majeure, a full refund of the tuition fee will be made.
 - Administration fee will not be refunded.
 - Refunds of other payments such as homestay fee, homestay arrangements and insurance will be considered on a case by case basis.
- 11. If Howick Intermediate ceases to be a provider or a signatory to the Code, fees for services not delivered will be returned to students.
- 12. The International Student Contract Dispute Resolution Scheme (DRS) can be accessed to resolve contractual and financial disputes. This independent scheme can be accessed here: https://www.istudent.org.nz
